Interns will also attend meetings with the Counsel to the Mayor and senior administration staff, and have access to professional development programming, including mentorship by senior attorneys.

About the Role:

Interns will assist on a number of ongoing projects. Key tasks will include:

- <u>Independent Research</u>: Research various local, state and federal laws, court decisions and legal authorities, and other legal documents;
- <u>Project Support</u>: Provide critical legal support to the Counsel to the Mayor and the Office's other attorneys; and
- <u>Coordination</u>: Work with senior administration officials on various transparency projects, including lobbyist reporting and compliance with the Freedom of Information Law.

- Currently enrolled at an accredited law school. Completion of 1L year or higher and in good academic standing;
- Strong analytical skills, attention to detail and ability to synthesize information into communications and messaging quickly and effectively are important qualities;
